• Fires are divisive, expensive, and erode trust



January 2025 LA Firestorm Recap

- 14 major wildfires across SoCal
- 200,000+ evacuated, 30 fatalities, 18,189+ structures destroyed/damaged
- Estimated economic losses: Insured
 ≈ \$45B; total losses possibly \$76–
 130B



Cleanup Efforts (California & EPA)



- Hazardous materials: 9,000+ parcels cleared in under 30 days
- EPA: 75% complete within 3 weeks; 12,000 properties surveyed
- Structural debris: Army Corps removing debris from 2,300 homes

Economic & Regulatory Impacts

➤ Governor's EO suspending CEQA, Coastal Act, and extending price gouging limits

- Financial support: \$2.5B in state funds + SBA loans; insurance moratoriums
- Rent hikes spiked up to 200%; now capped at 10%



Ongoing Litigation & Timelines

- Multiple lawsuits: SCE (Eaton Fire), LADWP (hydrant failure), County vs. Edison
- Renters suing over habitability violations, toxic ash exposure
- Insurance and environmental litigation ongoing
- Key deadlines: FEMA filings, cancelation periods, reconstruction contracts

- 4. Community conflict and recall threats



Handling Recall Risk - Now with Legal Context

- Use legal examples to support rule changes
- Address owner concerns head-on
- Make strategic concessions



Recall Response – Under the Threat of Litigation

- Stay compliant with legal communications
- Use board-approved attorney statements
- Document all decisions
