Committee Name: Community Outreach

Committee Purpose:

Committee Duties:

- 5. Brainstorm on new potential charities to partner with.
- 6. Submit recap articles to the Publications Committee within 7 days after each event.

Committee Calendar:

The committee meets monthly on the 4th Tuesday at 2:00 pm.

Committee Capacity and Attendance Policies:

The committee has voted and the CAI Board of Directors has approved that the maximum number of committee members shall not exceed 25. (7/2/2012)

Committee members are permitted to miss 3 meetings per calendar year. If a member misses more than 3 in a calendar year and there is a waiting list, that member is advised they will be added to the waiting list. After the 2nd missed meeting an email will be sent to that committee member reminding them of the attendance policy by a committee chair.
